Dear Applicant,

We are excited that you are interested in joining the Robins Civic Club as a Jr Member. We are a group of citizens from every walk of life and all ages with a common goal to make our community a better place to work and live. We are continuing to seek ways in which we may improve the community of Robins, through a variety of activities and welcome all newcomers to join us.!

We are excited to offer the opportunity for junior members (ages 14-18) to serve and to participate as volunteers and shadow our chairpersons for the variety of activities. We see this as a twofold enrichment for each person who participates, and the service provided to the community as a result. Service hours will be documented for each junior volunteer.

We currently sponsor the Robins Roundup and 5 K run June, an Easter Egg Hunt (Mar/April), a Halloween Trunk or Treat Activity (October), Christmas tree lighting ceremony (Early December), a summer farmer's market (June through Sept). We support improvements to the parks, banners for the streets and for the past 14 years three scholarships for high school seniors to assist in their educational pursuits. The scholarship applications are usually due in March.

The largest area with leadership opportunities is the Robins Roundup. The following is the list of our events and some of the opportunities available for a junior member.

Robins Roundup: We have several committees that having junior member involvement would not only provide insight but also extra hands for prep, social media advertising and continued investment into the community. Committee opportunities: kid zone with games, groups who bring activities to play, band committee, refreshment committee, parking committee, sponsorship gathering committee.

Halloween Trunk or Treat: Arranging the "sponsors of trunks", coordinate with the Fire Department for space and traffic pattern, advertising.

Christmas Tree Lighting: Coordinate for singers, setting up with fire department for use of facility. Order cookies, obtain volunteers to serve.

5K race: Working with the chairperson on scheduling the chip/bib timer, setting up the "Get me Registered" online link, updating Save the Date Flyer, ordering T-shirts w/Sponsors, updating the paper Entry form, ordering medals, gathering volunteers for the water station and route safety, getting bananas and water for the racers & volunteers.

Easter Egg Hunt: Coordinate for the Easter Bunny, the fire department participation, stuff eggs, gather volunteers to set up the day of the hunt, place parking signs, egg recycle bins.

We expect you will be assisting as a volunteer in these and future events.

The Civic Club meets once a month the second Tuesday of each month from 7 p.m. to 8 p.m. in the Robins City Hall 265 S. 2nd St Robins, Community Hall. During the meeting, the Club discusses upcoming events and progress



updates from the Chair/Co-Chairs of each event. It is understood that leading is a process and a mentor would partner with the junior members with one of the committee chairs for these various events. This will assist in the development and growth of some leadership skills and provide service to the community.
